

PET FOODS APPROVED FOR PESACH 2024

Since one is not allowed to have chametz in one's possession over Pesach, nor to derive benefit from it, one cannot feed pets on Pesach with foods containing chametz, nor can one keep such food in the house. The general advice on suitable alternatives has been provided by qualified Veterinary Surgeons.

As far as manufactured products are concerned, many common brands of pet foods contain cereal and are therefore not suitable for Pesach. The following products have been investigated and some found to be chametz free. (They have also been checked for mixtures of Meat and Dairy from which one is similarly prohibited to derive benefit throughout the year.)

They may contain kitniyot and therefore care should be taken to keep them away from kosher l'Pesach utensils, sinks and surfaces.

It is recommended that approved pet foods are purchased before Pesach.

BIRDS

Parrots, Budgies, Cockatiels and Lovebirds can be given a variety of seeds and sprouted seeds (such as peas, lentils, beans), but no more than twice a week as they may cause obesity and health problems. Leafy vegetables such as dandelion leaves, parsley, kale and spinach, as well as carrots and sweet potatoes, are also recommended. Fruits and fruit juices can be given but again not more than twice a week as they contain sugar, which leads to obesity. Sugar free baby food based on vegetables or fruits is a suitable alternative.

CAT FOOD

If the approved products are not suitable, cats can be fed poached fish or meat and given water to drink.

DOG FOOD

If the approved products are not suitable, dogs can eat poached meat or fish mixed with a small cup of boiled white or brown rice (cooked in separate utensils as it is kitniyot) and vegetables such as broccoli or carrots (not onions, garlic, leeks or other alliums as these are poisonous to dogs!).

If the dog is accustomed to dry dog foods, it is advisable to move over gradually to the new diet a few days before Pesach to allow time to adjust.

FISH FOOD

Whilst fish should be maintained on their pellet or flake food for the bulk of their lives, a week on an alternative diet should do them no harm.

Frozen cubes of bloodworm, cockle, mussel, lancefish, brineshrimp etc may be purchased from aquarium fish shops. These should be free of grain derivatives, provided they are not vitamin enriched. Tiny items of fresh fruit such as orange flesh or broccoli are also suitable.

Please note any uneaten food should be removed from the water after 40 minutes or so.

GUINEA PIGS

Guinea pigs should be given plenty of hay and green leafy vegetables.

HAMSTERS

Hamsters can be given small pieces of matza, fruit, vegetables and nuts.

MICE & RATS

Mice and rats are essentially omnivorous and can be given vegetables, small pieces of meat and cheese, dried insects such as mealworms, as well as tiny bits of matza.

RABBITS

Rabbits will do very well if given plenty of clean fresh hay, supplemented with some green leafy vegetables such as cauliflower leaves, spring greens and/or broccoli, but the new diet must be introduced slowly over many weeks to encourage them to eat it.
